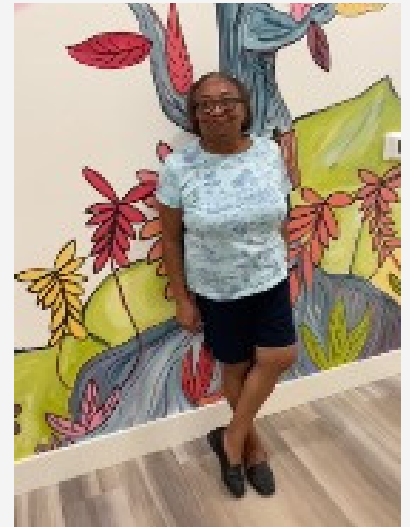


GET CONNECTED

As a member of the Delafield Co-Op Market, located at 1005 Boatlanding Rd, (rear entrance off Pearl Street), I wanted to invite all neighbors to come in and complete a membership application if you haven't already done so. You can meet Patty Lowry, Deborah Wright, and Greg Byrd, our new Market Manager, who will be happy to help you.

Hours of operation are Tuesday, Wednesday, Friday from 10-4 pm, Thursday 10-6 pm, and Saturday 10-1 pm. Patty says they accept EBT, check, and cards. They have bulk pinto and black beans, rice, granola, farm raised fresh meats, home grown veggies, fruit, jellies, meal, flour, maple syrup and many other goodies.

The year-round fruit I like the best is the bananas. I use them for my cereal and also a good banana pudding from scratch.

5 bananas*
3 cups milk*
1 c. sugar
3 whole eggs
Pinch of salt*
1 box vanilla wafers
2 Tbs all purpose flour

*Items available in market

Filling : Beat eggs in milk. Add sugar, salt and flour. Put in a medium saucepan and cook until thick. 1 small baking dish layered with cookies, top with bananas. Repeat until you use all the bananas. Then pour the hot mixture over the bananas and vanilla wafers. Let cool before eating.
